3) Portfolio

A portfolio, consisting of 10-15 slides of recent artwork or scanned images (jpegs) on a CD or DVD, should be submitted to the School of Fine Arts. CD/DVD submissions must be cross-platform. The artwork can be in any media and any imagery, and should display conceptual, thematic, and/or narrative cohesion and the potential for artistic growth. Do not include renderings that are simply reproductions of copied images. Slides should be sent in a clear, plastic slide sheet and must be individually labeled. An identification list with this same information should accompany the portfolio. Include a self-addressed envelope, with adequate postage, for return of portfolio. Please do not submit elaborate portfolio covers or encase pages in plastic sheets. All materials must be able to fit inside a standard 8.5" x 11.5" manila file folder.

Identification list should include the following:

1) name

2) media

3) dimensions (if applicable)

4) date

4) Personal Statement

Submit a Statement of Intent to the School of Fine Arts that is separate from your USC application essay. In it describe your goals, abilities, and potential in the field of studio art. Your statement should explain why attending USC will help you reach those goals, and give a clear and accurate picture of you as an individual.

5) Letters of Recommendation

Transfer students should submit 2 letters of support to the School of Fine Arts. The committee will be looking for recommendations from art instructors who are familiar with the applicant's creativity and dedication to the field of intended study. (Freshmen applicants do not need to submit letters of recommendation.)
