**Academic Records**

Submit official copies of all college transcripts to the USC Office of Admission and to the USC Roski School of Fine Arts. Scores for the GRE are not required. All foreign applicants must submit recent TOEFL scores.

**Personal Statement**

Submit a 1500–2000–word essay to the USC Roski School of Fine Arts that describes your interest in the Master of Public Art Studies, and how this course of study relates to your personal objectives and past experience. Add any other pertinent information regarding your application. The statement should be typed and double-spaced.

**Writing Sample**

Please submit a previously written academic paper. (You may also include a published essay, if available.)

**Letters of Recommendation**

Submit three letters of support to the USC Roski School of Fine Arts. The committee will be looking for recommendations from those who are familiar with the applicant's scholarship, creativity and dedication to the intended field of study. There are no special recommendation forms.

**Dual Degree Applicants**

MPAS/MPL applicants must also apply to the School of Policy, Planning and Development. Dual Degree candidates are required to submit GRE test scores. Applicants should contact both the Public Art Studies Program and the School of Policy, Planning and Development for information and admission requirements. MPAS/MA applicants must also apply to Hebrew Union College–Jewish Institute of Religion. GRE scores are required.
